There are many aspects of Church Life at First Light with the primary purpose to serve First Light Church and our community. In this past year, we carried this out in a variety of ways. For regular attenders and visitors, we held three Discover Membership Meetings. This meeting is an in-depth look at the history and purpose of First Light Church. In our Upward Sports Ministry, we have 247 children participating in the games of volleyball and basketball. The majority of these participants come from our community. Another area is Vandalia Butler Teacher Breakfast. We have hosted the staff and faculty on their

This past year, we averaged serving 70 football players and coaches weekly, over a 12-week period. LIVESTREAM

2024 was an exciting year for our livestream experience! With a full video system overhaul made possible by your generosity, we installed new cameras and streaming equipment to give online viewers an experience as close to being in the room as possible. This investment has paid off! Since our system upgrade, average online viewers have almost doubled, with more people finding our livestream and connecting with us. Our average watch time has continued to grow, with over 1,521 unique viewers totalling in just under 8,000 views just since June. That's almost a 10% increase in viewership made possible by your generosity and investment into the future of First Light Church. BUDGET

This year's First Light Church operating budget is a conservative financial target based on previous years' budget-giving trends and this year's budgetary requests from church ministry leaders. It is an increase of \$244.78 per week compared to the 2024 weekly budget receipts. The weekly budget target for 2025 - 2026 is \$32,499.37. The Church Elder Council recommends it for a vote by the membership in its February 26, 2025, Church Conference.

Throughout 2024, First Light experienced numeric growth in many ministry areas, including preschool ministry, student ministry, and livestream viewership. The church saw nearly 50 people attend Discover First Light and over 30 people baptized. First Light also saw 35 new giving units added to its budget giving and a 5.2% increase in giving compared to the previous year. This budget helps support that growth and momentum that God is blessing our church with.

For 2025, a trend of rising operating costs continued. The cost of employee health insurance increased again by 11%. Operating expenses such as building insurance, utilities, and consumable goods continued to rise and experience the effect of inflation. The Elder Council also extended a cost-of-living increase to the church's staff and a funding increase to its local mission partners. These factors, paired with the growth in ministry participation, drive a need for more significant funding across nearly all of the church's budget line items compared to past years.

The following details provide an overview of First Light Church's 2025 - 2026 Operating Budget. This budget is made possible by the gifts of the people of First Light Church and the Lord's provision to meet our church's ministry needs. We trust the Lord will continue to provide.
